The National Natural Resources Policy, produced by WG must take into account the most recent State of Natural Resources Report.


Area statements will facilitate the implementation of the national natural resources policy by:

What benefits does good air quality provide?

What <u>resources</u> provide these benefits?

What gives us good air quality?

What is the current state of the resources, what are the recent trends?

How does the evidence form part of the picture to show resilience of ecosystems?

What are the <u>pressures</u> on the resources?

What will make air quality worse or stop us improving it?

What is the <u>future outlook</u> for the state of the resources?
